Message from Pastor Kim



Most of us have a favorite holiday season. For some, it's Christmas with the family get-togethers and presents. For others, it's summer with the planned vacations or Thanksgiving Day with a big banquet of food and warmth. But at just about this time of each year, very few people would pick Lent as their favorite season.

Lent is the period of 40 days which comes before Easter in the Christian calendar. Beginning on Ash Wednesday, Lent is a season of repentance, fasting, and preparation before the celebrations of Easter. It is a time of self-examination and reflection. In the early church, Lent was a time to prepare new converts for baptism. Today, Christians focus on their relationship with God, often choosing to give up something or to volunteer and give of themselves for others.

The season of Lent also offers us a great opportunity to reflect on our faith and our Savior. Lent is a time for us to acknowledge our shortcomings and our need for transformation. It is vitally important to admit that we have fallen short of God's expectations for us, but it is even more important to be reminded that God's love never ebbs, even in the face of our lack of commitment or action. Redemption, renewal, and transformation are eternal, unfailing promises.

Lent can be considered to be a yearly "second chance" for us to take a long, loving look at our lives to see if our values and priorities are in line with God's desire for us. Since all of us find that we've wandered from God's path, Lent becomes that second chance to return to God with our whole heart.

Lent is a season of being invited by God in a deeply personal way. God wants to have a deeper and intimate relationship with us. He calls to us, "Come back to me, with all of your heart."

As we journey together, we are reminded that we are not alone and that we have a community from which we can draw inspiration, support, and hope. I hope that we will take some time during Lent to listen to God's encouraging words, and that we will not only recognize the benefits to our lives, but we will also have the opportunity to share those moments of encouragement and transformation with others. As we journey through this annual "second chance," remember that each step brings us closer to the welcoming arms of our loving God. I pray that we will experience the deeper, wider, and bigger love of God this Lent, and hopefully, we will be able to say that Lent is our favorite season this year.
