Cornerstone Supports Overseas Missions

March's mission offering of \$743 supported Esther Chan and her work in China with BOL Harvester Foundation. In February, Esther and her husband, Chin Lee Chan, came back for a visit at Cornerstone. A former ROCK (Representatives of Christ's Kingdom) leader in the 1990s, Esther was recently called to serve in China. She shared with our congregation about the restrictive conditions by the Chinese government and about the difficult social pressures faced by the Chinese people and their families. Many people have moved to the cities and away from their villages and families for work, which has strained marital and familial relationships. Esther's work with the underground church is helping to provide social support, which is a great unaddressed need in the Chinese society.

The April missions offering of \$1,416 will support our very own Ryan Low. Ryan is a senior in col-

lege at Cal State Fullerton, and he is a leader with the Epic Movement Christian group. Earlier this year, he was selected as a missionary with EPIC/Campus Crusade for Christ to minister overseas in East Asia. His mission trip will be from May 23 -June 14, 2019. During his mission trip, Ryan will attend language classes and have a chance to engage with college students. During his missions moment presentation, Ryan shared how God has put a desire in his heart to share the gospel with other college students. Knowing what God has done in his own life, Ryan wants to be able to share his faith and experiences with his peers.
