In August, CUMC collected \$588.68 which was sent to the Homeless Intervention Shelter and House (HIS House) in Placentia. Their organization operates a 54-bed transitional housing program for those needing safe shelter and supportive services. During the Covid pandemic, their work is especially meaningful for vulnerable members of our community who are trying to reestablish themselves with permanent housing and employment. Thank you, Cornerstone, for your generous support for those in need in our community.

During the month of September, our missions committee members and friends had the unique opportunity to participate in Project Independence's virtual Walk for Independence. Usually Project Independence hosts a large community event that brings together walkers, families, friends, and community members to support and encourage those with developmental disabilities. Although everyone wasn't able to physically gather this year due to the pandemic, it did not dampen the enthusiastic spirits and support for this amazing organization. Team Cornerstone consisted of 12 members including: Pastor John Wang, Richard, Pam and Walter Fitch, Bock and Wei-ling Louie, Yin Lu, May and Robert Quon, Winston and Kay Wong, and Stacey Wong. Each member walked at their home, around their neighborhood, or on their treadmill. Project Independence asked walkers to submit their step counts and walking pictures that were shown during the livestreamed Facebook event held on September 12th. During this live-streamed event, Cornerstone was recognized for the Largest Team and Stacey Wong was recognized for Most Steps for the event. We received two \$50 gift cards from Target as prizes, which will be used to purchase Christmas gifts for the Friendly Center's Holiday Toy Drive in December. The September missions offering of \$786.72 will be given to Project Independence for our team's participation and as a donation to their organization.

Our church's October mission offering will support OC United, which is a non-profit organization based in Fullerton whose purpose is to empower individuals, families, and communities through restorative relationships and whole-person care. At the time this article is being written, the final tally of the October missions offering is not available. This information will be provided in the next edition of the newsletter. †
















Message from Pastor John Wang

Dear Beloved Church Family,

As the months go on, I hope all of us are taking advantage of this time of quarantine to gain more knowledge, learn new skills, and better understand God's will for our lives. 
